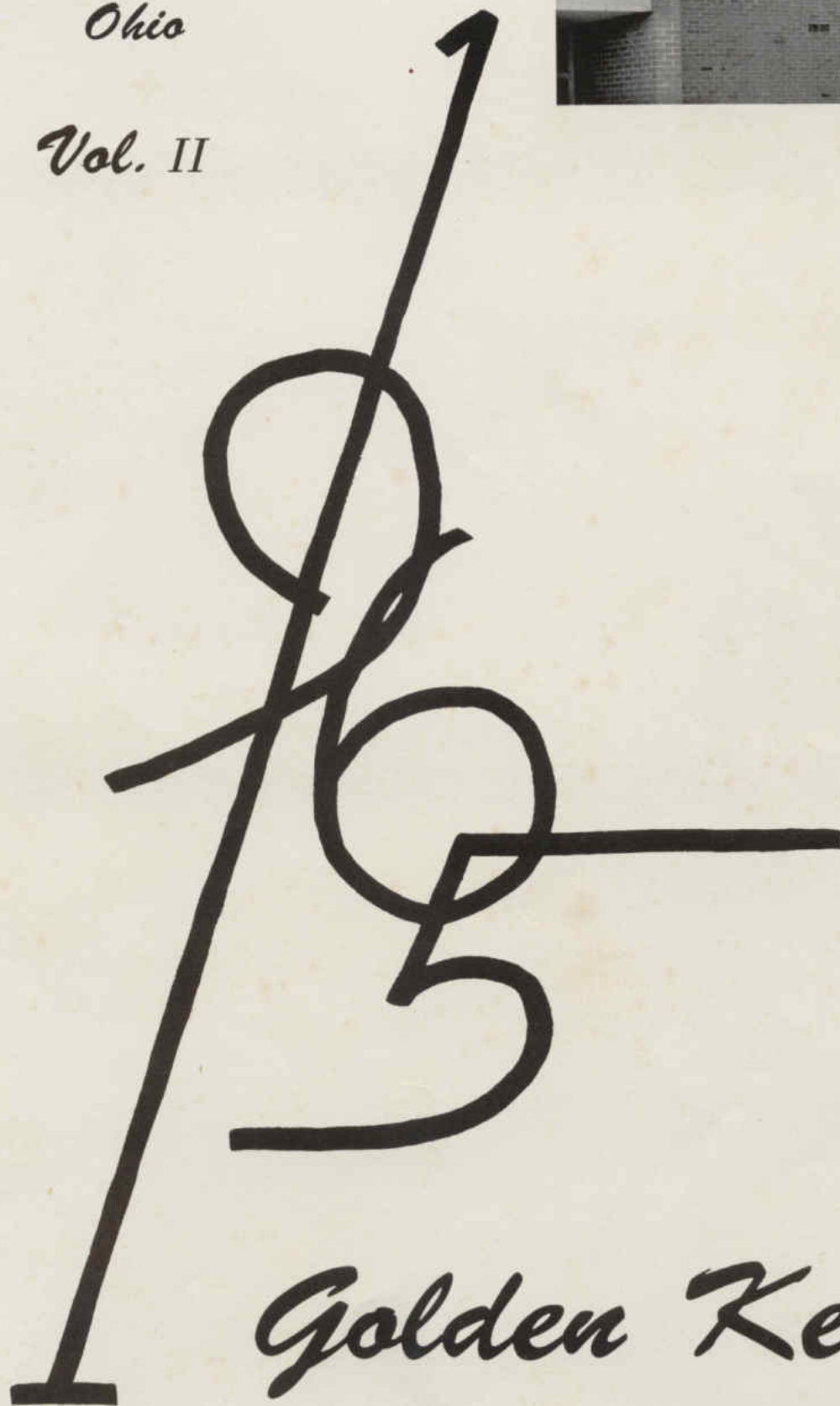

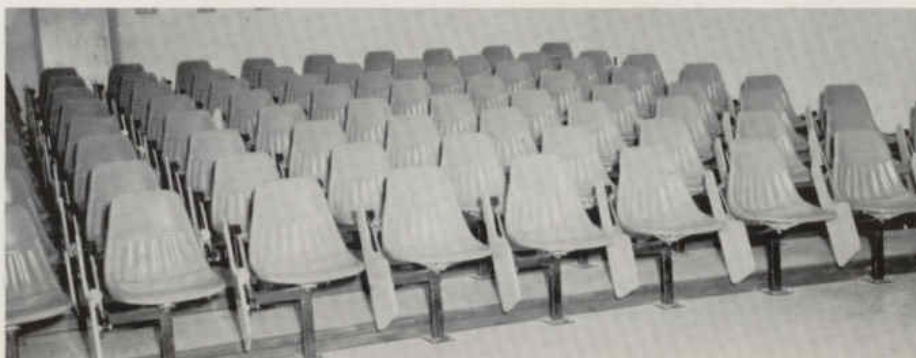

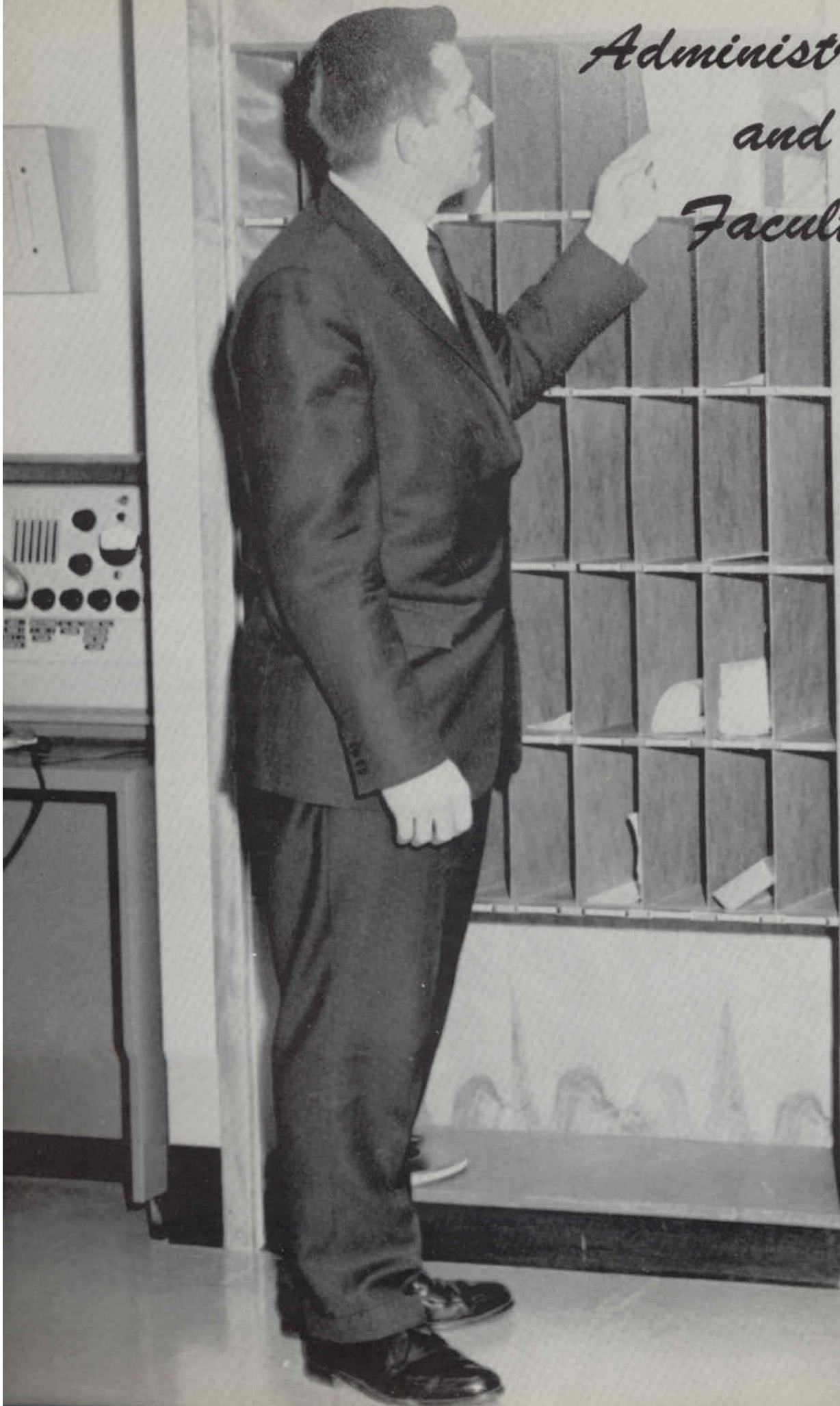

Members of the graduating class of 1965, I congratulate you upon your accomplishment and extend to you my best wishes for your future.

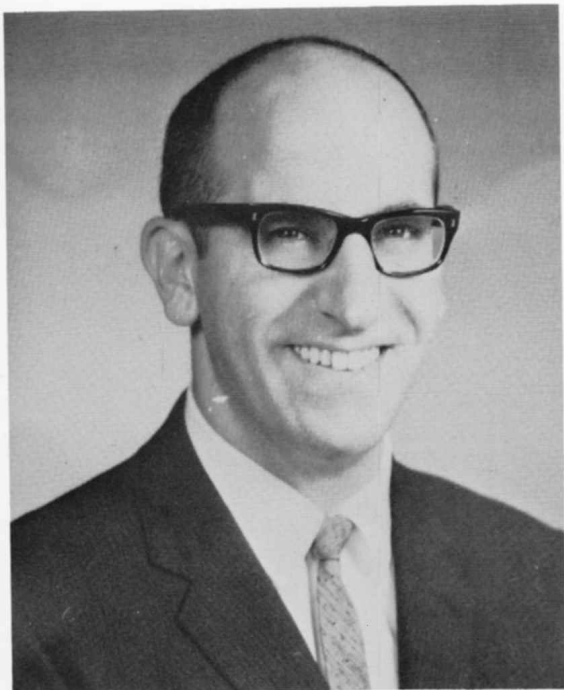

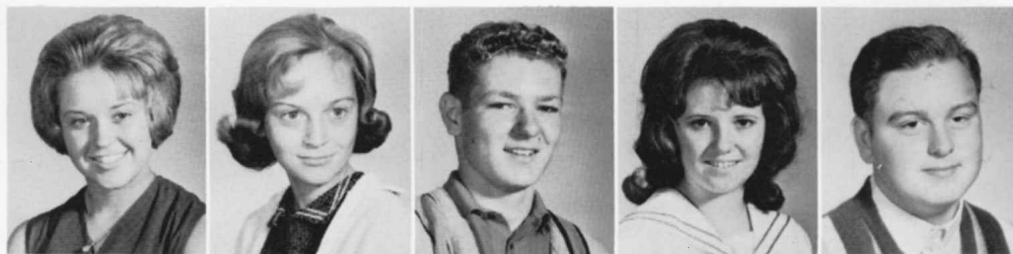
Under the careful guidance of their teachers, this class had many on the honor roll. By attending games, dances, and joining clubs, they helped to boost the school's spirit.
