Through their various activities, the Juniors have had many rewarding experiences and wish the best of luck to all future Junior Classes.

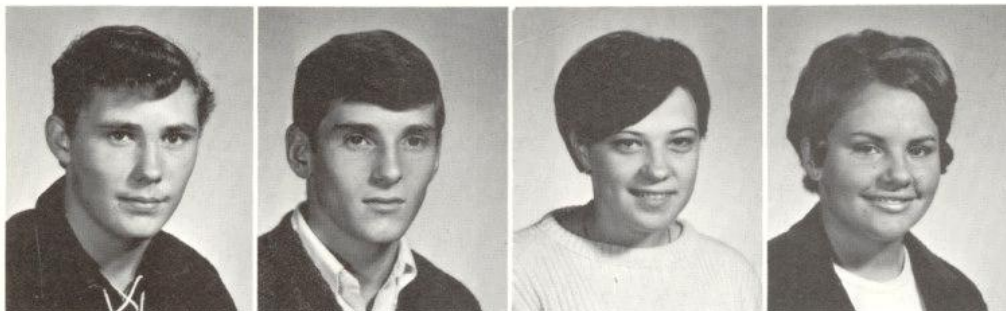
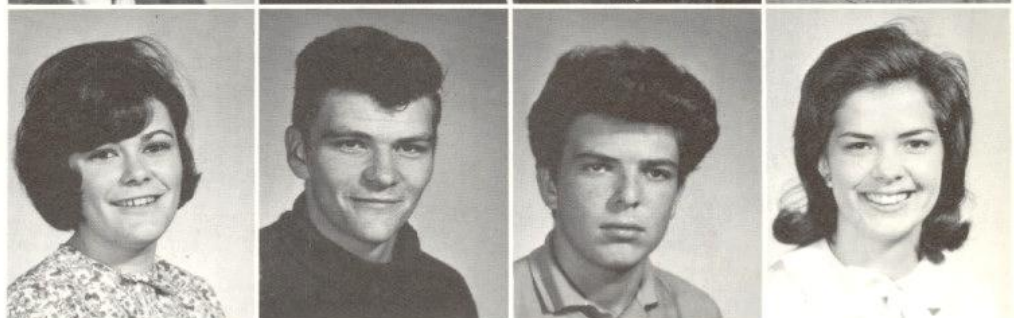

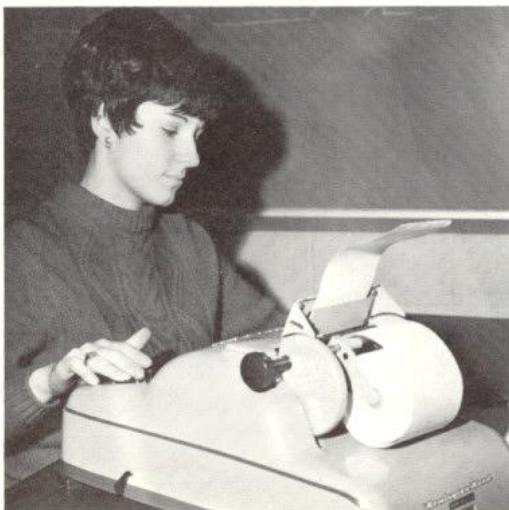
