


## "Winning the Championship Feels Great"

Homecoming finished with an unbelievable 43-0 against the Mogadore Wildcats. At the close of the season, the Rockets were predicted to lose over Champion in the Akron Beacon Journal. They showed their colors and won it 10-6. A championship banquet was held for our winning team at the Cathedral of Tomorrow Buffet. Senior Dirk Krakora was awarded the Most Valuable Player. It takes five runners on a seven-man team to score. The first five runners completing the set course scores for the team. The final standings are determined by the least number of points.


Although the team competed well and the scores were always close, the Cross-Country team had a fairly disappointing season.




