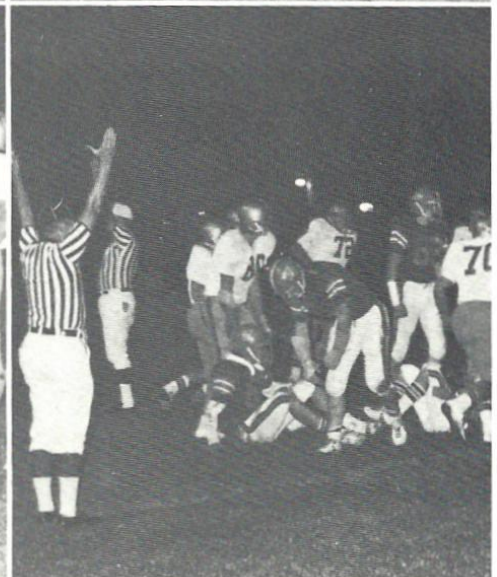
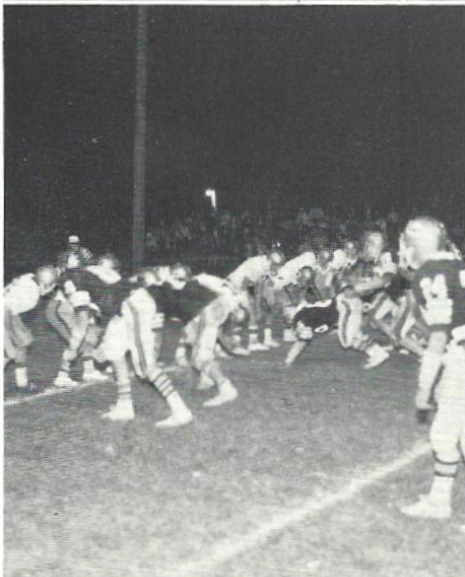
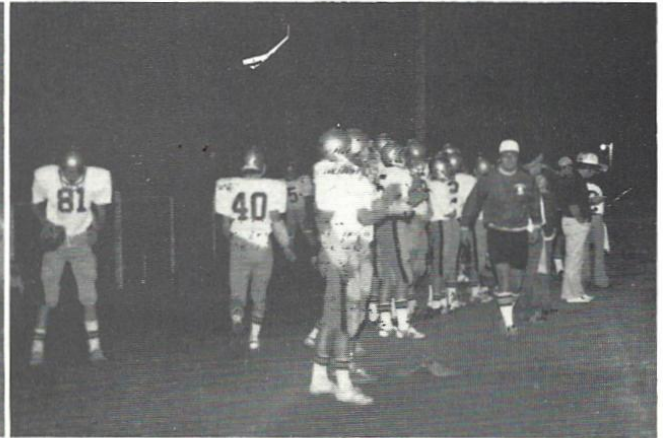
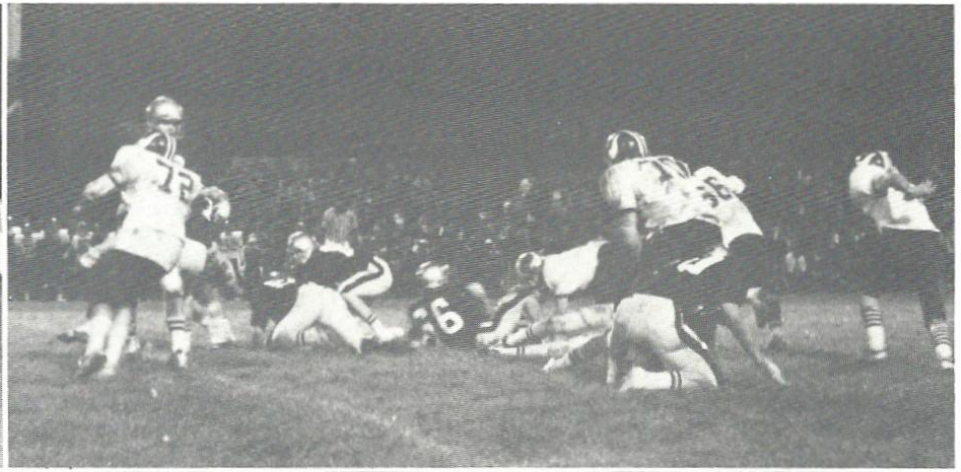
"Winning the Championship Feels Great"

1. The 1975 Football season was the greatest in this school's history. For the first time in 13 years, the Streetsboro Rockets won a P.C.L. Championship. After the first few games their point spread widened. Then Crestwood came, the game which proved to be the toughest of the season. The game ended in a 10-10 tie. Homecoming finished with an unbelievable 43-0 against the Mogadore Wildcats. At the close of the season, the Rockets were predicted to lose over Champion in the Akron Beacon Journal. They showed their colors and won it 10-6. A championship banquet was held for our winning team at the Cathedral of Tomorrow Buffet. Senior Dirk Krakora was awarded the Most Valuable Player. Steve McMullen was Most Valuable Defensive Lineman, while Ken Barlett was picked Most Valuable Defensive Back. Dennis Bontrager walked away the most Valuable Offensive Lineman, and Bob Quesenberry the Most Valuable Offensive Back. Picked by the team, sophomore Steve Perry was Most Improved Player.

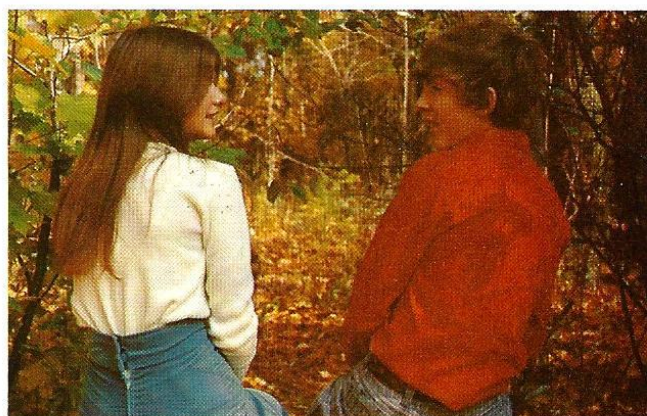

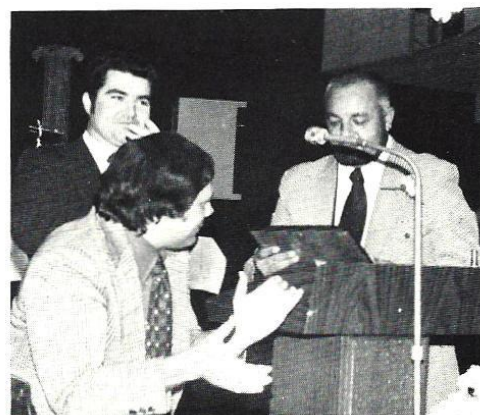

It takes five runners on a seven-man team to score. The first five runners completing the set course scores for the team. The final standings are determined by the least number of points.

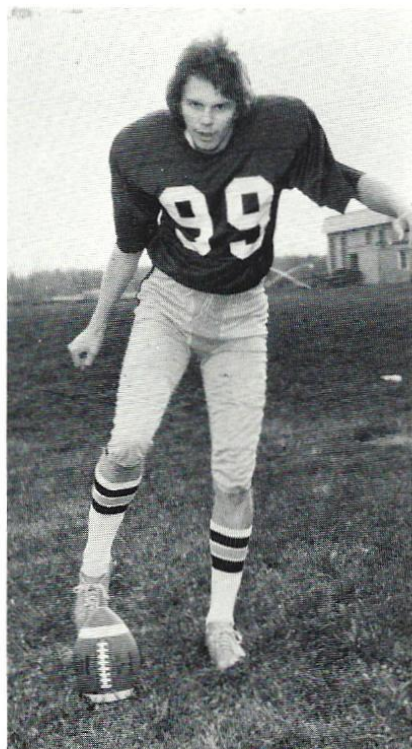

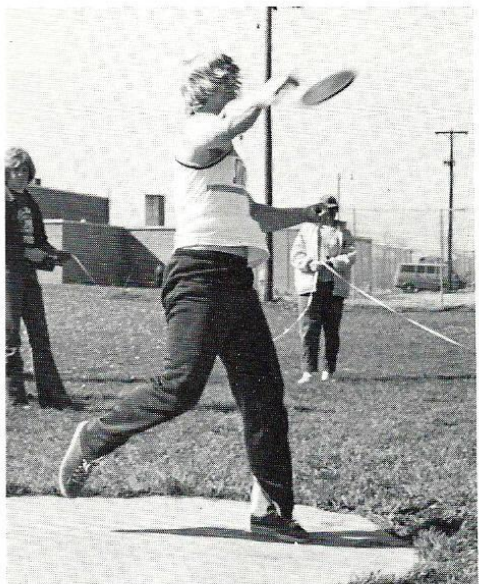
