
Because of the notable records set this year by Wyzynski's Winners and the goals they left for others to follow, we know that the future can only hold good things for girls volleyball at Streetsboro.











Taking both the dual meets and the PCL tournament, the Rocket wrestling team won their title outright this year. With tons of talent and terrific coaching from Mr. Marek, Mr. Combs and Mr. Taggart, they just couldn't miss.

The team also set a new school record with the most ALL-PCL wrestlers ever. Six boys, Brad Horne, Jeff Horne, Dave Pavlick, Gary Pavlick, Tom Taggart and Rick Iverson were given this prestigious award. Four of whom were champions at their weight classes. These were: Brad Horne 112, Gary Pavlick 138, Tom Taggart 155 and Rick Iverson HWT.

The Rockets did fairly well in tournament action too. Bruce Lash and Rick Iverson both took a first place at sectionals, while Bruce went on to finish eighth in the state tournament. 
